Recorded vote of members of the Senate on SB 365: AN ACT concerning elections; relating to ballots; requiring the return of advance voting ballots by 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election; requiring the hand counting of ballots; prohibiting the use of electronic or electromechanical voting systems and electronic poll books; providing for the public reporting of vote counts during vote canvassing.



SB 365: Advance ballots would have to be returned to the election office by 7:00 pm on election day. All ballots must be hand counted. No electronic ballots would be allowed.

802 Position: Opposed. The United States Postal Service has become so unreliable, it is not realistic to expect advanced ballots to be returned by 7:00 pm on election day. The current window of three days after the election is appropriate for the ballots to be returned to the election office. Hand counting ballots are suspectable to human error. Requiring the use of only paper ballots will increase the workload of the election office and board and possible increasing the cost of elections.
