

HB 2703: Makes one change to the qualification for at-risk funding. In addition to all of the previous qualifiers identified for a student to receive at-risk funding, this bill adds "is in the custody of the secretary for children and families." In other words, if a child is in foster care they will qualify for at-risk funding and services.

802 Position: Support.

Students who find themselves in foster care come often come from families who love them but are unable to provide a stable home environment. Research shows that the lack of a stable home environment can impact a child's ability to learn. At-risk services can assist the student in working towards reaching grade-level proficiency.
