

Oral vote of members of the House Committee on Health and Human Services on HB 2556: AN ACT expanding medical assistance eligibility and enacting the cutting healthcare cost for all Kansans act.



HB 2556: Allows the state of Kansas to expand Medicaid to cover many of those individuals who fall within the gap of coverage.

802 Position: Support. Kansas is one of only ten states that has not taken advantage of expanding Medicaid. Expansion would reduce health care costs for everyone, and at the same time, it would ensure affordable health care for all Kansans.
